

## General Rules for Public Presentation Day

1. Dress for Success – Your attire should be presentable and proper for what you are doing.
2. Posters: Each presenter should make his or her own posters. Use black or blue markers and BIG LETTERING- 1 inch letters are a good size and easy to view from 30 ft.
3. Tables, easels, stove, microwave, and extension cords are available. Please list supplies needed on the registration form. All other supplies are furnished by the participants. **Come prepared.**
4. At each event, 4-H'ers will receive certificates with an excellent, good or worth award. Awards will be presented in individual rooms throughout the day as convenient.
5. Cloverbuds, 5-7 year olds, are eligible to participate in Show and Tell. Cloverbud presenters receive a certificate and gold seal.
6. For Power Point presentations, the presenter is requested to display talking points and images or photographs. Do not display the entire text of the presentation. Rather, use the talking points and images as visual cues, similar to using a poster for cues.
7. Parents and friends are invited and encouraged to attend the event.
8. Please show respect to the presenters by not talking or distracting them during the presentations. Turn off cell phones.
