4-H School Outreach offers content rich, hands-on programs to elementary age children in Saratoga County Schools and Home School participants. Classroom teachers select from a variety of programs that support their classroom teachings and help satisfy Next Generation Learning Standards.

- All programs consist of a full hour of immersion in a specific subject in an age appropriate format.
- Information is presented in multiple forms including:
 - * Interactive large group discussion
 - * Individual and small group activities
 - * Hands on experience
 - * Visually, orally and quantitatively
- Program extensions are supplied for follow-up in the classroom.
- Allow 30 minutes for VIRTUAL LIVE portion of program with 15 minutes between presentations
- Presentations are designed to be fun, engaging, and to allow children the opportunity for practical application of new information as well as many chances for incidental learning.
- Current age appropriate technology is used for presentations.
- All programs include Teacher Packet with curriculum extensions to continue the learning.


