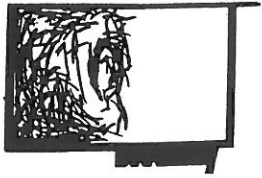
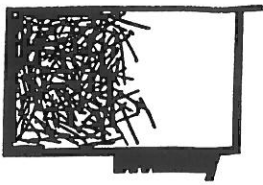


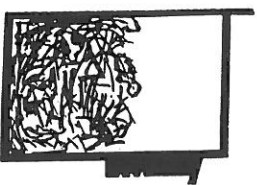
**IDENTIFICATION DIAGRAMS SHOWING

IN A BLUE BIRD HOUSE.**



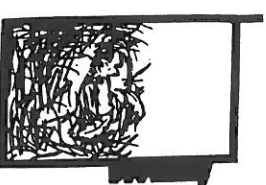
EASTERN BLUEBIRD  
Nest - Neatly constructed of grass  
Broods - Two per year  
Eggs - 4-5 pale blue and occasionally white



HOUSE WREN  
Nest - Twigs  
Broods - Two per year  
Eggs - 6-8 white speckled brown



ENGLISH SPARROW  
Nest - A mixture of grass, feathers and trash  
Broods - 2 or 3 per year  
Eggs - 5-6 Grey - white speckled brown



TREE SWALLOW  
Nest - Grass lined with feathers  
Broods - Usually one, occasionally two  
Eggs - 4-6 white
